Original word	Pronounced	Meaning
דְּבָרָה	Dibrah	Noun: Cause, reason, manner
דָּבַר	Dabar	Verb: to speak
דְּבָר	Dabahr	Noun: speech or word
שִׁים	Sim	Verb: to set, place, establish law, put into order
Τάσσω, τέταχας, τάξις	Tasso, tetachas, taxin	Verb: bring about an order of things by arranging, put into place
πρόγνωσις	Prognosis	Noun: Foreknowledge
προετοιμάζω	Proetoimatzo	Verb: Prepare beforehand
Προγράψω	Prographo	Verb: write beforehand
προγεγραμμένοι	Programmenoi	Having been ordained (programmed)
