- What does the term "usufruct" mean in the context of exercising dominion, and how does it connect with the First Imperative?

#### 4. Relating the Law in the Garden to Human Relationships:

- How does the relationship between Adam and Eve, as outlined in the Garden, contribute to the fulfillment of the First Imperative and the promotion of life and God's glory?
- What role does the concept of stewardship play in the relationship between man and woman, and how does it relate to the command to be fruitful and multiply?

#### 5. Connecting the Gospel Imperative to the Great Commission:

- In what ways does the Gospel Imperative echo the First Imperative, and how can believers today fulfill the command to "Be Fruitful and Multiply"?
- How does Christ's teaching of the vine relate to the idea of bearing fruit, and what does this fruit look like in the context of the Great Commission?
